

# Immanuel God with Us

## Week Two- Mighty God

*Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel (which means 'God is with us').*

*Don't be afraid. Just stand still and watch the Lord rescue you today . . . The Lord himself will fight for you. Just stay calm.*

*(Exodus 14:13–14, NLT)*

*If someone slaps you on the right cheek, offer the other cheek also.*

*(Matthew 5:39, NLT)*

### 2. When you need help, ask our Mighty God to provide.

*Until now you have asked for nothing in My name. Ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be complete.*

*(John 16:24, Holman Christian Standard Bible)*

*Now all glory to God,*

*who is able,*

*through his mighty power*

*at work within us,*

*to accomplish infinitely more*

*than we might ask or think.*

*(Ephesians 3:20, NLT)*

### 3. When you want to give up, trust our Mighty God for a miracle.

*Christ must reign until he humbles all his enemies beneath his feet.*

*And the last enemy to be destroyed is death.*

*(1 Corinthians 15:25–26, NLT)*
